In 2018, we initiated a long-term plan to meet the current and future needs of the Bank, and as I write this message, we are less than a month away from completing a two-story addition with the first-floor consisting of offices and a second-floor training center for employees and customers.

In the past fifty years, the number of community banks has decreased from over 14,000 to slightly less than 5,000. Over the next ten years the number of community banks is expected to decrease to 2,500. The addition, and upgrades to the existing facility, allows us to continue to attract and retain the quality people necessary to meet the needs of customers at all our locations and thereby continue to grow. We're excited about the addition and utilizing the training center. Yet, at the end of the day, it's a building. Pure and simple. Relationships, serving, and meeting the needs of customers will continue to be what matters.


GROWTH IN MANY WAYS


Farmers National Bank continues to grow in a physical sense with the addition of the Geneseo Bank in 1997, the Morrison Bank in 2007, and the addition to the Prophetstown Bank which will soon be completed in 2021. Growth can also be represented by investments in our staff, the communities we serve, and technology.

The bank now has 56 employees to serve you and nearly half, including the Ag Lenders pictured above, are involved in various ways to support over \$400 million in total loans including \$300 million to local agriculture. Deposits to help fund those loans have grown from \$415 million in 2015 to over \$555 million at year end 2020. Currently area small businesses, not for profits, and farmers are benefitting from Round 2 of the Paycheck Protection Program with over \$6 million of loan funds injected into the local economies so far in addition to the over \$9 million last year. Investments in Interactive Teller Machines (ITMs) and digital technology such as Mobile Banking and Person to Person payments will allow the bank to grow beyond its traditional boundaries.

The graphs below are just a quick snapshot of how the Bank has grown in both assets and capital during the last forty years. The growth is a result of past and present investments by the bank mentioned above, but most importantly, by the customers' investment in the bank for nearly 120 years.


